## NEXT STEPS

Your team should designate a Team Captain and Mentor. Thoroughly review the Team Captain Guidebook to become familiar with the Rules and Regulations, Design Principles, and the Design Process. ## DELIVERY & STORAGE

Starting Tuesday, February 7 through Thursday, February 9 teams are able to deliver their cans and other permissible items for structural support, to Rutgers University. Please contact the University directly to make your arrangements. Unfortunately, Rutgers University cannot provide staff or equipment to load your goods, therefore have two or three other team members on hand to do so.

Teams are encouraged to build their structures on a floor cover to protect the facility's tile floors. Acceptable floor covering includes rubber-backed/non-skid carpet, Masonite or pegboard.

## MISCELLANEOUS

Please bring a ladder, hand truck or flat bed for transporting cans from the storage area to the build out location. The Food Bank will have some volunteers on hand to help.
