#### JOIN OTHER SCHOOLS IN THE FIGHT AGAINST HUNGER

Students Change Hunger is a friendly competition where schools and youth groups host food drives and fundraisers to help feed our New Jersey neighbors. Participants compete to donate the most food or funds to help end hunger in our state.

From September 11, 2023, through January 12, 2024, groups throughout New Jersey compete to collect as much as possible for their local food bank. The organization that collects the most food and raises the most funds wins!

During the 2022 - 2023 SCH campaign, 142 schools and groups participated, donating more than 128,000 pounds of food and \$79,000 to their local food banks. In total, these donated resources supported 344,353 meals for neighbors in need.

This campaign helps to meet the need in our communities and teaches students the power of advocacy and outreach.

### **ABOUT THE FOOD BANK OF SOUTH JERSEY**

The Food Bank of South Jersey offers an immediate solution to the urgent problem of hunger by providing food to needy people, teaching them to eat nutritiously, and helping them to find sustainable ways to improve their lives.

In 2022, we distributed 18.5 million pounds of food - the equivalent of more than 15 million meals - to children, families, veterans and seniors in South Jersey.

Right now, nearly 100,000 South Jerseyans face hunger. That is 1 in 14 individuals and 1 in 11 kids who may not know where their next meal will come from. **But the FBSJ is here to change that.**

#### **RULES**

#### STUDENTS CHANGE HUNGER HAS A FEW SIMPLE RULES TO FOLLOW:

- 1. Schools must register for the competition at **foodbanksj.org/studentschangehunger** to qualify for awards
- 2. Food may be donated on or between the dates of MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 11 FRIDAY, JANUARY 12
- 3. The food must be delivered to the Food Bank of South Jersey
- 4. Schools must provide their own boxes/bins to store goods until delivery
- 5. When a food donation is made to the Food Bank of South Jersey, a Poundage Receipt must be filled out See donation form
- 6. Schools are responsible for checking "expired" dates on food prior to delivery
- 7. For every dollar that your school raises, we will credit your school with one (1) pound of food Start an online fundraising page at **donate.foodbanksj.org/**

Note: In the event of a tie, a pounds-per-student ratio will be utilized to determine the winner.
